Federal Law Guide To Holiday Employment For Teen Ager

Another hazardous occupation where injuries frequently occur is operating a slicer or grinder. In order to protect themselves against unintentional violation of the law, employers should obtain and keep on file an age or employment certificate showing the minor to be at least the minimum age for the occupation in which he is employed. In this case, such certificates are issued by local school authorities.

Melton reminded employers and young job-seekers that some jobs do not come under the Fair Labor Standards Act since it applied to employees and public contractors in interstate commerce, in the production of goods for commerce or in certain large enterprises engaged in commerce or the production of goods for commerce. However, he said that each State also has its child-labor law.
