Two Baltimore brothers have perfected a doll that can get a suntan. Dressed in blue swim suit, "Sandy" freckles, then turns a golden brown after a minute in the sun. The secret is a special coating which makes the body sensitive to light.

Many toy manufacturers believe clothes sell the doll. Consequently, high-fashion dolls may have 100-piece wardrobe, including monogrammed pajamas and miniature mink coats, smokers and swim fins.

"It costs more to clothe the doll than my child" moaned one mother.

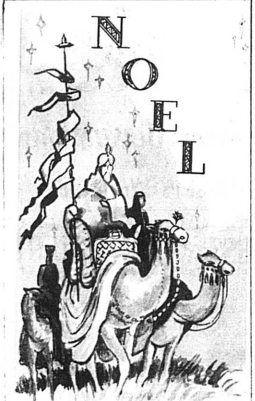

Mechanization of dolls is not new. American dolls were making and talking a hundred years ago.

As far back as the 18th century, two Swiss watchmakers built three incredible dolls that still write, draw, and play for visitors to the History Museum in Neuchâtel, Switzerland.

When wound up, the little author dips a quill pen in ink and writes "Welcome to Neuchâtel" in French. The artist sketches pencil portraits of Louis XVI of France and Marie Antoinette. The lady musician sits at the keyboard of a miniature 18th-

Home Furnishings That Help You Save Time
Are you looking for ways to save time? Your choice of home furnishings can help save time for you.

Some furnishings need less care than others, according to Kathryn Sobres, UK Extension specialist in home furnishings.

Consider ease of care

When you choose furniture, Miss Sobres suggests. Furniture that is simple in design is easier to dust and to clean. Light-colored furniture woods don't show dust as easily as dark woods.

Some chests, tables and desks have marble or plastic-coated tops that are resistant to heat, cold and moisture. These save time in removing circles, spots and stains. Pieces of furniture that have no pulls on drawers or use those metals that are treated to be tarnish-proof save the time spent in caring for ordinary pulls.

Your choice of fabrics also can save time for you. For example, bedspreads, curtains and draperies made of fiberduras don't need ironing. Slipcover and upholstery fabrics treated for spot and stain resistance are also on the market; they are called Scotchgard, Zepel or Syntex (these are not the brand names).

Chairs that have extra upholstery material or protectors provided for the arms also are time-savers, for washing or dry cleaning these pieces is easier than cleaning the entire chair.

Your choices of rug and linoleum colors, room accessories, and table furnishings can also save a lot of time spent in caring for these items. Miss Sobres says. Light colors in linoleum soil less, while tans and woods are practical for cloth than many small ones. Plastic-coated or fiber-table mats can be wiped off, thus saving the time that would be spent in washing and ironing tablecloths or cloth place mats. Stainless steel table ware saves the time that would be needed to polish silver. Finally, dishes and glassware that can go into the dishwasher

are time-savers, too. **Grab-and-Goos Steer Feeding Ties Again** in U. of K. Tests

Feeding beef steers on grass alone for about 60 days and then giving them shelled corn free choice the rest of the grazing season was successful, last season at the U.K. Ag Experiment Station.

Dr. Neil Bradley, beef researcher, says the test confirmed findings of the previous year as to the system's value. The first year such test animals graded choler in carcass. Last season they averaged high good to low choice in a similar test.

It seems to be a good way to combine the cattle, grass and corn and get the type of slaughter beef in demand now, he says.

Last year was not a good year for beef cattle prices, but we found we still did all right with our test steers on this system."
