lowing Christmas. To do so, let the plant get almost completely dry after the brackets begin to fade. This will usually happen in early January, and is easily accomplished by putting the pot on a shelf in a cool basement or other storage place. Even at this stage the plant must not be exposed to freezing temperatures.

After Christmas. For next Christmas take cuttings from the old plant rather than trying to get the new ones again. Cuttings should be about 6 inches long and should be taken in late July or early August. Root them in a small pot or cutting bench with a peat and sand mixture. Put them in a very shady place to root, and keep them quiet. Poinsettia roots are very brittle, so be careful when handling them.
