Indorse Principles Of Right To Work
For the first time in history, a Kentucky county and a Kentucky municipality have officially endorsed the principles of Right-to-Work.

According to the Executive Secretary of the Shelby County Chamber of Commerce, Joseph L. Tucker, the Shelbyville City Council passed a Right-to-Work ordinance at the Council's meeting Thursday, February 20. Prior to that, the Shelby County Fiscal Court passed a similar statement in the form of a resolution at its monthly meeting Tuesday, February 18.

"The action of both these official bodies constitute a first for Kentucky," Tucker noted, "and according to our records, no other local government has ever officially endorsed the principle

of a freedom to work document."

Both the Shelby County Chamber of Commerce and the Shelby County Farm Bureau endorsed a resolution to work resolution and urged the passing of same by the two Shelby County elected bodies.

"Right-to-Work" is not a state law in Kentucky, but it is in every other state in the South with the exception of Louisiana. The action by Shelby County officials should show the industrial world, the Commercial world, other local communities in Kentucky, and all other institutions interested in freedom of choice, that the people of Shelby County, Kentucky nurture this
