Other than serving as a food for other fish, the bluegill presents a highly desirable catch for the fisherman who prefers the bluegill to any other species, and is probably the bluegill provides the most food for other species.

Although a favorite of farm ponds, bluegill may be found in the largest lakes and to all streams. Throughout the spring, summer and early fall they may be caught, but it is indeed rare that a bluegill is taken from cold water.

Farm ponds usually open in May. As the water warms, the bluegill becomes more active. In fact, in many waters, he would not survive without this food fish.

That is the reason that the bluegill is a part of the balanced stocking program of the Department of Fish and Game. The bluegill keeps a steady

population of bluegill in every stream that supports fish life, in ponds and lakes, wherever there is pure water, there also will be found the bluegill and he's pretty apt to be around for a long, long time.

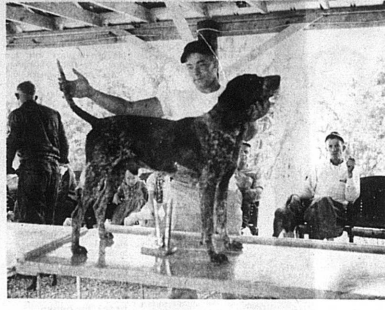

Tobacco Tangle
An effort to eliminate the price support program for tobacco met with resounding defeat on the Floor of the House of Representatives this week.
Representative John D. Dingell, D. Mich., offered an amendment to the Agriculture Department appropriations Bill which would have prohibited the expenditure of any of the funds to support the tobacco program. Representative Dingell, aroused and energized by the Surgeon General's Report, "Smoking and Health," stated he believed smoking was injurious to health, and that the Federal Government, therefore should not support this agricultural commodity.

We are expanding research both through the efforts of the government and private industry to determine the cause, if one exists, what factors with reference to tobacco cause it and what can be done to cure or help the situation."

An am pleasure to write that the House of Representatives in passing the Agriculture Appropriations Bill included \$1,500,000 for tobacco research to be conducted at the ideally equipped National Tobacco Research Laboratory connected with the University of Kentucky. It is very fortunate that Kentucky's Congressman Natcher is an important ranking member of the Agriculture Appropriations Subcommittee and a thereby able to recommend where research will be done. It is essential that extensive basic tobacco research be initiated as soon as possible and all Representatives from tobacco growing states realize this. The amendment, proposed by Congressman Dingell, however, would not have provided any answer to the health question, as we hope research can, but would have created catastrophe and chaos in the tobacco program. I am glad that an overwhelming majority of the members of the House rose to defeat Representative Dingell's proposed amendment.
