County Is 'Happy Hunting Ground' For Many Hunters

Nicholas County is a "Happy Hunting Ground" for many hunters. The Department of Fish and Wildlife Resources, almost 300,000 fish (Bass and Blue Gill) have been released in Nicholas County this year. An- nually there are approxi- mately more than any other state in the Nation except Alaska. Addition- ally, there are eleven major lakes, thousands of minor ponds and perhaps 100,000 farm ponds. At least 60,000 turkeys, ducks, geese and swans. Fur bearing animals are hunted through the county this year. An estimated 1.5 million rabbits & squirrels are harvested in Kentucky annually. Most hunting and fishing is done by sportsman for recreation. However, there are a few commercial fisher- men and hunters.

The Nicholas County Fish and Game Club, one of the most active clubs in the Nation, promotes organized fish and coon hunts that attract thousands of hunters.
