Dear family and friends:  
Just like a small church mouse, I tipped up the side of the nine hundred year old Lutheran Church, climbed up to the loft, and sat waiting for the people to come. It was to be a Norwegian wedding and I was the uninvited guest, except from the priest who thought that the young American IFYE might like to see the "bridegroom." The wedding march began and the bride entered with the groom. She wore a Norwegian national dress and her bridesmaid did, also. They sat near the altar, sang a hymn with the guests, then stood for the ceremony. I missed most of the words (my Norwegian vocabulary doesn't include words for the wedding ceremony) but I did understand the "do," which means "I do." The church was not decorated, but it would have seemed out of place in the beautiful, old church with the wood carving around the altar and walls. The ceremony lasted for three quarters of an hour, then just as simply as they entered, the wedding party left. I stayed in my place until the church was empty, then went to the priest for my "tour" of the church. As I expected, there is much history behind it. Although it is a rural church, it is so large that I felt I

should make every word a whisper.  
I am living now on a prestegard, a priest farm, if liberally translated in English. There I have many opportunities to learn of the church, mission work, and how a state-owned farm is operated. I live with the farmer who operates the 30 acres of crops. It took only one day for my host brother to start me as a potato picker, but the work is done with good machinery, so it isn't hard labor! It is the harvest season for barley and potatoes, so it means every one goes to the field to help. Between potatoes and barley, my host mother and I have gotten in some strawberry planting, canning berries, and freezing vegetables.

I am in southern Norway, the tiny south! Every large town is a seaport, with the ships, fishing boats, and private boats lining the docks. I like to see boats coming in and out of the ports—it is just like the mental picture I had made before I arrived in Norway! Even in a small country the land can vary from place to place. We have winter coming soon here, but I look forward to seeing the high, snow-covered mountains that I have heard so much about and which have drawn so many tourists to this country.

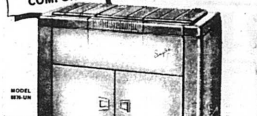
