

Cockroaches

A Problem?
If you thing you've "fried everything" -- without success -- to get rid of cockroaches, you have the same problem as many other home owners. Richard Miller, U. K. Extension Service entomologist, says you may have failed in your anti-cockroach campaign for any of several reasons.

Perhaps you used the wrong insecticide. The German cockroach, which causes the most trouble in homes and is the most difficult to control, has developed resistance to several insecticides, especially chlordane and dieldrin.

Or you may have used the wrong formulation. Aerosol bombs of limited value because cockroaches hide so well to hit all of them with these sprays. Usually sold in glass containers, are helpful, but they contain a low percentage of insecticide. In addition, these often are used only for spot-spraying -- usually, many areas where cockroaches develop are missed when these sprays are used.

First, take all dishes, pots and pans, supplies and wash the cabinets well with soap and water. Then apply the insecticide mixture described above (low odor malathion and water) with a paint brush or tank spray. "You can better control the application of the insecticide if you use a paint brush," Miller points out. "If you use a spray, be careful not to allow drift. Remember that insecticides are poisonous, so be sure to read and follow the precautions on the label."

Check boxes of stored products and throw away those that show signs of insect infestation. The malathion mixture will control other insects that infest stored food products as well as cockroaches, he points out.

Allow cabinets to dry thoroughly before putting in shelf paper and replacing utensils and supplies. Then use the insecticide mixture to treat areas behind the stove and refrigerator, hardware, areas where cockroaches meet the floor and walls, and any other places where cockroaches are seen.

Finally, don't forget to repeat this treatment in three weeks and then monthly as needed. Further information on cockroach control is available at your county Extension office. Miller concludes. Ask for Ky. Co-operative Ext. Serv. Miscellaneous 289 "German Cockroach Control."

Treat Plant Beds Spring Dividends
Fall-treated plant beds are like blue chip stocks; they bring dividends, says Ira Massey, U. K. Ag Extension Service tobacco specialist. "The plant bed treatment done in the fall means farmers have that job finished when spring rolls around," he said. Some recommendations: 1) PROPER SITE: Should be fertile, well-watered area, free from shade, close to a water source. Pick a site (if possible) away from the tobacco bar or weed areas where diseases have been present. 2) PLOWING: Do this at least two weeks before treatment, earlier if possible. Plowing eliminates the tobacco bar or weed area and brings the soil to surface for easier killing. 3) WORKING BED: Do this in relation to your

proposed weed control plan. If burning is used, only top of dirt turned up needs to be knocked off. If using a drench or chemical, make a thorough seed bed and break up clods. WEED TREATMENT: Soil temperature must be at least 50 degrees F for any method used, and soil dry enough to work. Don't treat if soil temperature is less than 50 degrees F. Materials used in fall-treatment are just as effective if soil temperature is not below 50

degrees F) as they are when used any other time of the year. Incidentally, temperature of soil is measured one inch from the top.
