

Boat Sales Statute Revised

Frankfort. The Kentucky Division of Boating has received an opinion from the Attorney General's Office regarding who is a boat dealer in boats according to a 1960 boating law.

According to boating Director Bill King, many service stations in Kentucky and used car lots are selling boats without having registered with his division. The revised statute calls for a dealer in boats to register with the Division of Boating and to pay an annual registration fee of twenty-five dollars to the division.

Assistant Attorney General George F. Rabe has said that a dealer is "one who buys to sell again." Rabe also said the words of the statute are to be given their usual, ordinary, and everyday meaning.

Rabe added, "The registration statute is free of ambiguity. It requires the registration of dealers in motorboats in terms which are all-inclusive. A reading into the statute of an exception for dealers in used motorboats would be unwarranted. It is therefore our opinion that the sale of used motorboats by filling stations and used car lots makes the operators thereof dealers in motorboats and subject to the registration requirements of KRS 228.220."

DEPOT ANNOUNCES DEER HUNTING DATES

Deer hunting dates for the Lexington-Blue Grass Army Depot, near Richmond, Kentucky have been announced by Depot Commander, Colonel William F. Starr.

Archery hunting has been scheduled for October 17, 18, 24, 25, 31, and November 1. Shotgun hunting, using #1 1/2 ammunition only, will be permitted on November 29-30. Rifles will not be used for hunting on the reservation.

Persons desiring to hunt at the depot should submit a request to the Provost Marshal, Lexington-Blue Grass Army Depot, Lexington, Kentucky before 4 p.m. October 1. Requests are to be submitted on postcards only. Letters will not be accepted and requests are limited to one per hunter and should contain his name, address and whether hunting will be with bow or gun.

In accordance with procedures, all cards will be placed in a container and names will be drawn to fill
