**Improved Alloys**

**For Saving Teeth**

Joint departmental research that under way at the University of Kentucky eventually may provide dentists with improved alloys for preserving teeth damaged by decay.

Professors of operative dentistry and metallurgical engineering are participating in the research. According to Dr. Mateer, studies will be directed at examining currently used dental amalgams or alloys (fillings) to determine which one who clings into the dental chair to note their structural qualities and how they have changed structurally after long or long service.

Dr. Mateer said, "at some amalgams last from 40 to 50 years while others serve for only five or six years. This presents a puzzle because about 90 per cent of all amalgams employed by dentists are of the same silver-tin-mercury combination."

The metallurgist said he foresees no attempt to adopt new metals for dental repair as a result of the research project, only the opportunity to improve, if need be, on the alloy combination and application of the amalgam materials now used.

Dental and metallurgical sciences have greatly advanced since the old frontier days when a dentist whitened a silver dollar and packed the pulverized shavings into a hollow tooth with mercury, but the principle for warding off a throbbing ache is still the same.
