Let's Look It Over

Frankfort—This is a salute to the great thoroughbred industry of Kentucky which reached the highest peak

Our song leaders Cheryl Herrin led us in group singing after which the meeting was adjourned by our president, Howard Livingson Jr., Reporter

More than anything, though, this is thanks to an industry which has meant so much through the national attention it draws to Kentucky, and the taxes it pays, the business it generates to the economic well-being of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

This year's Kentucky Derby, according to reports, broke all records in attendance which habitually is pegged at 100,000.

Thoroughbred racing is legal in 28 states, including Kentucky, and tens of thousands of the residents of this state have never risked the pari-mutuel minimum of \$2 on the outcome of a horse race, the benefits they derive from the proceeds of the industry are great.

Total tax revenue from Kentucky race tracks received by the State for the fiscal year ending last June 30 amounted to \$3,651,702. This consisted of a pari-mutual tax total of \$5,326,359; race track admission taxes of \$40,843, and race track licenses (one each a day) of \$174,500.

Besides being one of the most popular spectator sports in Kentucky, as demonstrated by attendance at Churchill Downs and at the preceding meeting at beautiful Keeneland in Fayette County, thoroughbred racing has tremendous impact on the economy of cities, counties, and states where it is staged.

In addition to more income from pari-mutuel taxes, which benefits roads, schools, hospitals and other state services, the spectacular growth experienced by racing in the last few years has resulted also in an increase in land values. Land values, always high in the Bluegrass, have rocketed to \$1,000 or more an acre with appreciability in the last few years because of the establishment of more Thoroughbred farms.

Frequent mention has been made of Churchill Downs in this salute because of the recent Derby there, and mention also has been made of Keeneland. I pay the same tribute to these other thoroughbred racing plants and to the
