How does this compare with 1965? Last year, net income was \$14.2 billion, including government payments of \$2.5 billion. This is somewhat less than the gain of \$2 billion as percent of the government news release which included direct federal payments in total income figures.

Agriculture publicists also confuse the income picture in reporting average net realized income of \$4,900 per farm in 1966, or an increase of 16 percent over last year, and not pointing out that the decrease in the number of farmers boosted the per farm average.

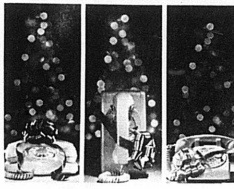
