TOBACCO STALLS
Left In Open Lose
Nutrients In Winter Rain
Leaving them to leave tobacco stalls in the open, nearly three-quarters of the nitrogen, potassium and phosphorus in the stalls can be lost to normal winter rains, says F. L. Smiley, U.S. Cooperative Extension Service agronomy department tobacco specialist.
"If you can't put stalls on meadows, pastures, etc., pile them where they are protected from winter rains."
