North's Heavy Snows Drive Xmas Tree Grower to State

When Ivan Coots of near Buffalo, N.C., decided the region's heavy winter snow cover was delaying his Christmas tree growing project, he looked several places as a replacement area.

Philadelphia, Baltimore and Cincinnati were the alternate possible sections. The 100-acre site in Campbell County looked the most promising.

Coots was in 1955. Today, 10 years later, Coots is letting the public harvest any one of some 35,000 Scotch or white pine Christmas trees per 80 cents a "bright" foot for it—and have the fun doing it.

Last year, for instance, he had a successful "marketing season." His farm located near Alexandria and Silver Grove and only a few minutes by good highway from Cincinnati, Newport, Covington, Fort Thomas and all the other city centers in northern Kentucky (a million and a half people) was a busy place last year to hire an extra worker to handle the parking chore.

Coots is a little surprised at his success. He moved to Kentucky permanently in 1963, though he set up his new operation in 1955 and came down from Buffalo every year for the important time that he had in New York.

"I used to be the only major commercial Christmas tree grower in this area. Last year, I even had people come from as far as Dayton, Ohio to buy trees. I averaged about 55 acres on each tree I sold. But I enjoyed it. People coming for trees in a happy mood, and are cooperative. I simply check them in at the gate here, and tell them what tree they want. When they come back through this one entrance, I measure the tree and charge 80 cents a 'bright' foot for whatever they buy."
