the whole United States. Consideration of these facts discloses what chance a customer has of recouping his sales costs in a referral sales scheme based upon the purchaser furnishing the names of ten other customers to the salesman.

There are only little more than three million persons in Kentucky and less than 197,000,000 in the whole United States.

Those who foster sales referral devices of this type customarily sell items at exorbitant prices to individuals who are induced to make the purchase on the belief they can recover all or part of the sales price by referring ten other customers to the salesman. Simple mathematics proves this soon becomes impossible.

This month such schemes become illegal as violations of the state lottery statute as a result of the passage of Senate Bill 270, sponsored by the Consumer Protection Division of the Attorney General's Office in its effort to protect the rights of the buying public.
