COMMUNITY COLLEGES
The day is coming when the majority of American college students will enroll in community colleges. That prediction comes from Dr. Ellis Hartford, dean of the University of Kentucky's community college system. Today's reports, more than 1,200 students are attending over 780 two-year colleges throughout the nation, most of which are public. "Community colleges," he adds, the majority of this country's college students will be starting their higher education in community colleges. Dr. Hartford sees the community college movement as the third stage in the development of American public education. The first, he says, lasted throughout the second half of the 19th century and the first decade or two of this century, when an eight-grade education was the goal. Most parents seek for their children, during the era between world wars, alma generally were raised to include graduation from high school. The third stage—education beyond high school—has come to the fore in the last 20 years, says the UK dean, who terms the community college movement the "most dynamic force in American education" throughout that period. Graduation from a two-year college or curriculum probably will become the standard achievement of the majority of college youth by 1980, he believes. 60 per cent of the UK administrator predicts. By that year, he believes, 60 per cent of high school graduates will seek admission to college and 80 per cent will elect some form of post-high school job preparation.

Taxes Top Home Budget
Taxes cost more than any other item in the household budget. Americans work 168 hours and 19 minutes of every 8-hour day to meet Federal, state and local tax bills, says the U.S. Department of Labor in a new study. The time period is one minute less than that of last year. The other costs include housing, household operations, 1 hour 30 minutes; food, 1 hour and 16 minutes; transportation, 39 minutes; clothing, 31 minutes; recreation, 21 minutes; all other 1 hour and 6 minutes.
