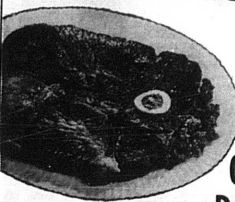

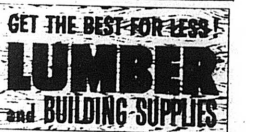

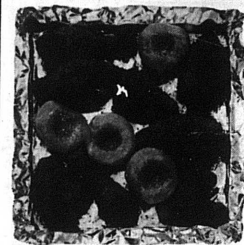

Fort Leonard Wood, Mo. (AHTN) - Army Pvt. Clifford C. Reid, son of Mr. and Mrs. William O. Reid, Route 1, Moorefield, completed a combat engineer course at Fort Leonard Wood, Mo., during the eight-week course. Reid was trained in the construction and repair of roads, railroads and bridges. Reid also received training in demolitions and mine warfare.

The 19-year-old soldier entered the Army in October 1965 and completed basic training at Fort Knox. He attended Nicholas County High School.

Army PFC Robert A. Crump, 22, son of Mr. and Mrs. Taylor Crump, Route 2, Sharpshurg, is undergoing a tank crew qualification at the Seventh Army training area at Grafenwohr, Germany through March 21.
