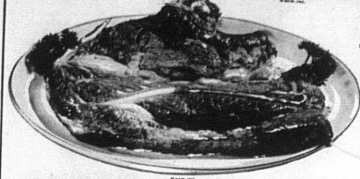

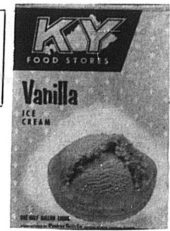

Timothy and Daniel day or two the past week with Mr. and Mrs. Fred Gaunce.

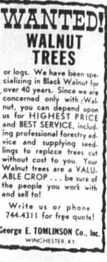

Buyer, Beware!

Probably most of us have purchased a used car or at sometime will. We listen to the motor, look at the body, inspect the tires and check the mileage. We inquire about other things, but low mileage is an important consideration. The thought may occur to us that the odometer reading may have been tampered with, but isn't that against the law? That's true, it is, KRS 434-410 makes it unlawful for any person fraudulently to change or disconnect the speedometer to sell a car, order to sell a car. But enforcement officers can't check every vehicle. So when the Consumer Protection Division learned that a Greenville, S. C. concern was circulating Kentucky automobile dealers offering to sell a device by use of which they boasted, "Even your secretaries can reset a speedometer in just 3 to 10 minutes without removing it from the car and without missing her hair," the Consumer Protection Division took immediate action. Result—this ease means of gyping the buyer was barred from the state and the offenders brought to the attention of Federal postal authorities.
