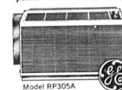

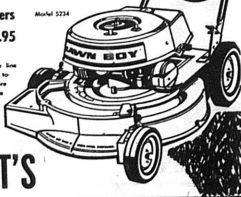

Cut Waste At Home - Save Water, Money

Cut waste at home and you not only save the cause of water conservation—but save money in the process. According to the May issue of Changing Times many areas will face water shortages this summer in spite of heavy winter and spring storms. The magazine lists these ways to save at least 350 gallons of water a week.

1. Instead of running the tap to let the water get cool every time you want a drink, keep a pitcher of water in the refrigerator. Saving: 2-3 gallons daily.
2. Don't wash or rinse dishes in running water over an open drain. Turn water on the rinse, then shut off. Saving: 10-15 gallons.
3. Use the automatic dishwasher only for full loads. Saving: 12-15 gallons.
4. Don't let the water run all the while you shave, brush your teeth or soap your hands. And don't run it till it's warm if you're going to wash your hands. Saving: 3-4 gallons.
5. If you're taking a shower, turn off water while lathering, then turn it on to rinse. Saving: 4-5 gallons.
6. If you have a "hande" on your automatic washer, use it. Saving: 15 gallons.
7. Repair leaky faucets and toilets. Save 4 gallons a day for each leak.
8. Use less water when you take a bath. Saving: 8-10 gallons.
9. Use a bucket of water to wash the car and water to rinse. Saving: 3-4 gallons.

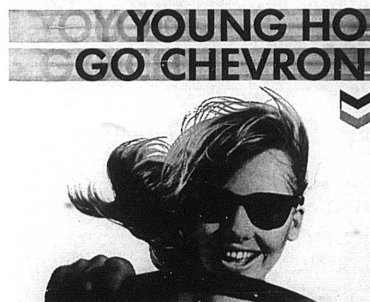

Washington Report From Your Congressman

A Congressman has many duties. In contrast to a popular general opinion held by many persons, a Congressman's duties far exceed that of the legislator whose sole function is to represent his constituents simply by casting a yes or no vote on pending legislation. In reality, a Member of Congress spends hours working directly for his constituency's views on legislation. These extra duties may involve such tasks as fulfilling a request to supply copies of bills pending in the Congress; assisting a seaman in an emergency home leave when tragedy strikes; assisting constituents who have eligible relatives ad-

mitted to the United States; or expediting Government decisions on constituent problems concerning social security benefits, veterans' benefits or Civil Service benefits. Especially important, a Congressman devotes a great deal of time in assisting cities and local authorities in his District as well as his state. These efforts may be directed to helping the governmental bodies participate in Federal local programs, to see that his District obtains an equitable share of the Federal money from programs enacted by the Congress, such as aid to the nation's schools, libraries, and urban renewal projects—to name just a few. In short, a Congressman makes every effort not only to represent his constituency's views, but also to represent the constituents individually or collectively by dealing with their local government or state representatives, on all matters with the Federal Government in which his constituents may have an interest or concern.

Many people view their Congressman as the man who can cut through the infamous "Red Tape" for which the Federal Government is so renowned. This is correct but it does not mean influence or change the final decision. While I, and I am confident my Colleagues share this opinion, wish to assist in every way to assist in every way to obtain a favorable decision through influence and favoritism, above and beyond the law, we would have total chaos. If favoritism and influence ruled, we would not have a government of laws providing equally for all men, but would have anarchy with the rights, privileges and freedom of everyone in constant jeopardy. And we would all be the loser. At this time of year when performance of everyone's thoughts turn to Federal income taxes, you may have surmised, a Congressman does not receive calls for assistance. It is only natural that many of my constituents have the past and will in the future have problems with their income tax and their income tax returns. I have always been glad to make inquiries, and obtain facts and expeditious consideration of any of the problems of my constituents. It is my policy and the policy of all Members of Congress, however, not to attempt to interfere with, or influence, the tax authorities as to their decisions regarding whether or not a person owes more or less taxes; or whether or not their tax returns are complete or accurate; or to interfere with the courts in their decisions on tax matters. This policy and philosophy in the Congress has been enhanced greatly by the conviction and sentence imposed on Members and top Federal Government officials in the past, who undertook to influence such a decision. Should Members of Congress or Government officials indulge in similar tactics today, they would, and should, be equally subject to criminal prosecution and probably conviction. For this reason I hope that my constituents continue to call on me for information and expeditious handling of their tax
