**Memorial Day Length Set At Carnico**  
Local Conservation Officer Harry Duncan has limited the Mercury to publish the minimum site limits on fish that may be taken from Lake Carnico. The regulation is as follows:  
The minimum length of bass that can be taken from Lake Carnico is 12 inches and was set by Minor Clark, Commissioner of the Department of Fish and Wildlife Resources, with concurrence of the Department sources. Commission as per KRS 150.025.  
The measurement to be made from the terminal end of the lower jaw to the tip of the longest tail fin. Bass less than 12 inches in length must be returned immediately to the waters from which they were taken in the best physical condition possible.
