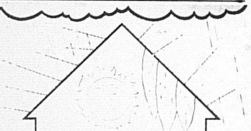

**Questions On Revised Constitution**

Q. What are the principal changes which will strengthen the legislature?  
A. The main improvements are: annual sessions, instead of one every two years; the empowering of the legislature, by a two-thirds vote, to extend the 60-day regular session by an additional 30 days; lengthening the terms of House members from 2 to 4 years; of senators from 4 to 6; the creation of the office of Inspector and Examiner, to serve as a "watchdog" for the legislature over appropriations and implementation of legislation; AND CHIEFLY, by designating the General Assembly as a continuing body.

Q. What is the significance of the legislature being a "continuing body"?  
A. This designation makes it possible for committees of the legislature to meet between sessions, to conduct research, hold hearings, or pursue any other legitimate functions. Legislatures would retain their committee assignments and thus become more expert in their fields of interest. They would be better prepared for their legislative tasks, and render greater service to the Commonwealth in their elective jobs.

Q. What is the effect of removing the \$100,000 limit on casual debt for the Constitution?  
A. Instead of stating the debt limit in terms of dollars, the revised Constitution would set the limit at 2 percent of the preceding year's revenue—a logical and fiscally sound provision. This change
