William Summerhill, director of the Bluegrass area, said the assignments are a basic part of the Cooperative Extension Service's switch-over to the new system which began July 1, 1965.

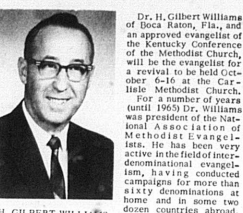
Administrators have been working out assignments lists since that date. The present list is the result.

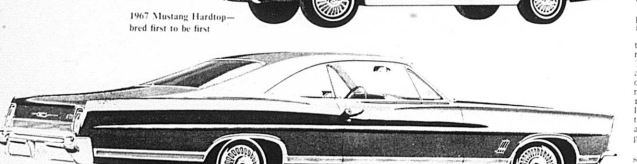

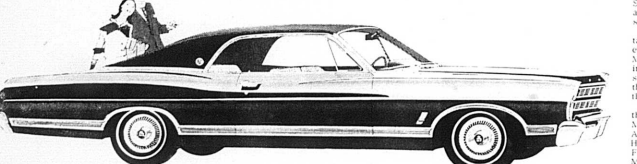

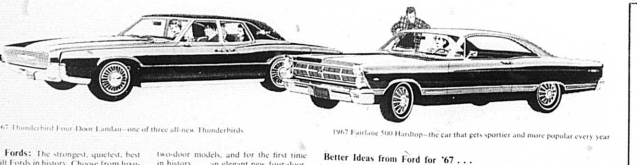
