The list of persons who have switched to Ward is too long to report here, but notable among them is Mack Walters of Shelbyville who was Chandler's state campaign chairman in 1963. State Senator William

Sullivan of Henderson, who was aeromastics commissioner under Chandler and has supported both Chandler and Waterfield, has joined Ward forces for the primary.  
These switches in allegiance have occurred all across the state, but they are not all one sided. For instance, Breathitt's local government commissioner, Ted Marcum is supporting Chandler after breaking with Breathitt to enter the race himself and then withdrew to support Chandler.

Buckman has supported Chandler and Waterfield both in past years and strongly supported both Combs and Waterfield, but is taking out on his own this time as a candidate for the office of governor.

A new switch in support comes from former State Senator Casper (Cap) Gardner of Davison county who supports both Chandler and Waterfield and was State Majority Leader in 1964, has said publicly that he is going to support Marlowe Cook.

Willie Lovett, Davison county chairman for Waterfield in 1959, is now supporting Ward as is banker Max Duncan of Corbin. J. Hicker Lewis of Burnside has gone to Ward's camp.

Tom Mobley of Warren County, a former advisory highway commissioner for Chandler, is now reported to be for Ward. State Representative Fred Morgan of Paducah, who has been an ardent Chandler and Waterfield supporter down through the years, is now for Ward.

On the other hand, Dr. E. Taylor Hydon of Prestonsburg, who supported Breathitt, is reported to be switching to the Chandler camp.

Publisher W. J. (Snook) Crutcher of the Morehead News, who has been a loyal Chandler supporter through the years, and was for Waterfield in 1959, is now supporting Ward. Publisher Andrew J. Sorfleet of the Russell Springs Times-Journal has switched from Chandler to Ward.

Holmes Ellis, mayor of Murray, is now for Ward, as are Attorney Clay Shackelford of Richmond; Ray Hays; and Grady Sellers of Fayette County; former State Senator Charles A. Davis of Breathitt County; Cecil Sanders of Lancaster; and a host of others. These developments just add more confirmation, to the strangest campaign Kentucky has seen in more than a quarter of a century.

**Crowds Cheer Ward Rally**

Louisville, Ky. — Cheers roared through Freedom Hall for Henry Ward as the Democratic candidate for governor spelled out step by step his program for progress in Kentucky.  
One observer at the fund-raising rally called the crowd "just too big to estimate" but others pegged its size at from 10,000 to 12,000 friends and supporters of Ward.

"We men will fight harder—work harder—be more dedicated to what's best for all of the people of Kentucky, for all sections of Kentucky," the former highway commissioner and conservation commissioner pledged.

"I will build Kentucky, not tear it down," he said.

Ward told the huge audience his administration would ensure that "taxpayers, particularly the overburdened owners of property, are protected, and that the wrong which have grown up over the past many years are corrected."

He called government "the people's business" and he said his election would guarantee strong efforts to:

"Expanding and improving education."  
Campaigning to get new industries into Kentucky "so that a job will be available in Kentucky for every person needing a job."

"Planning and building" a road system that provides safe transportation from the hollows to the highways.

"Aiding our farmers in solving the problems that beset them so that they share fairly in income and progress."

"We picked them because they are the kind of men who are interested in the welfare of Kentucky," Ward said.
