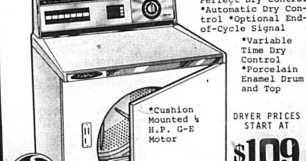

MORE JOBS In Local Service Industries

(Special to the Mercury)
NEW YORK, Nov. 30--With each passing year, more and more workers are needed in Nicholas County to provide local residents with the various kinds of services that go with modern living.
The demand is for more beauticians, more plumbers, more teachers and more electricians, as well as more bus drivers, nurses, bank clerks and other service workers.

As a result, the number of people in these fields, and the payoffs for them, have been rising steadily. So notes the Census Bureau after gathering data relating to the labor force from all parts of the country, where more women in Nicholas County who were employed in the service sector of the economy in the past year reached 28. This is exclusive of government employees and of those engaged in domestic service and agriculture.
They constituted no less than 21.1 percent of the total number of local workers—service and production combined—covered in the report.
The service industries listed include

such diverse types of businesses as advertising agencies, banks, barber shops, laundries, restaurants and automobile service stations. It also covers auto body shops, retail stores, movie theaters and places providing personal services ranging from hair to body massage.
In Nicholas County, the payroll for the year for these service workers amounted to \$74,000.
As a proportion of the payroll for all local workers covered in the report, this is the service category which is the largest.

The National Bureau of Economic Research finds that "the United States is now a service economy in that it is the first nation in the history of the world in which more than half of the employed people are not involved in the production of food, clothing, housing and other tangible goods."
The shift to services, it holds, has had a stabilizing effect on the economy as a whole. It has helped to cushion the decline in manufacturing employment caused by automation.
