

CENTRAL KENTUCKY... LEXINGTON--A heavy infestation of cutworms is reported in Central Ken-

tucky, says the entomology department of the U.S. Cooperative Extension Service. The species, identified as the bronze cutworm, will damage blueberries, other berries, grain and corn. The cater-

pillars can be identified by five light stripes down its body. If usually found near the ground on broad plants, but also will climb and damage apple trees, says Dr. Rudy Schoeller, entomologist.

CONTROL: Toxaphene is the recommended use for the field for 28 days after treatment, and can not graze on treated areas until 28 days after treatment. Toxaphene is a powerful insecticide which may be used. It is not as effective as toxaphene on plants or from such fields fed to livestock soon after the treatment has been applied.
