Dial Brings Changes
All telephone numbers in Nicholas County will be changed on November 19 when we change over to the dial system.
Business men often have cards and other advertising material printed well in advance. So we would like to suggest that you plan for your supply to be exhausted by Nov. 19.
The cost to convert Carlisle's telephone system to dial operation will be approximately \$500,000. It will be the latest and most modern system that can be provided.
The new dial system will include facilities allowing the dialing of long distance calls directly by the subscriber. This is known as DDD.
