The 11th annual Tobacco Festival will be held at the Carlisle Armory on Nov. 9, according to S.R. Barlow, chairman.

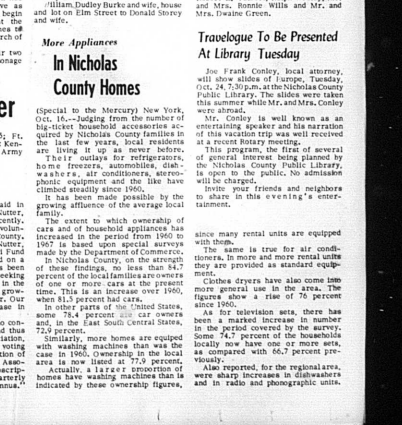
Travelogue To Be Presented At Library Tuesday
