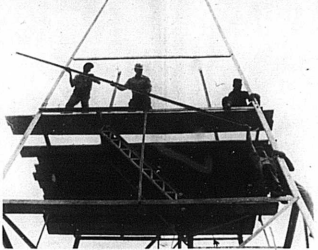


Taxpayers Ask IRS

This column of questions and answers on Federal tax matters is provided by the local office of the U.S. Internal Revenue Service and is published as a public service to taxpayers. The column answers questions most frequently asked by taxpayers.

Q-My income for this year has been lower than I expected. Can I forget about the next installment of my estimated tax or do I have to file an amended declaration?
A-If your tax liability appears to be greater or smaller than you originally estimated then an amended declaration should be filed. You will find the form for doing this printed on the bill for the third installment which is due September 15. If you do not receive a quarterly bill, send a postcard to ask your local IRS office for a copy of Form 1041-ES (Amended).

Q-Just started my first job. How many exemptions should I claim for withholding purposes? I'd rather get a refund than have more taxes to pay next year.
A-If you claim no exemptions on your withholding certificate then more will be withheld from your paycheck than if you claim one exemption for yourself.

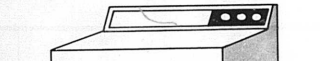

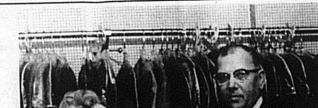
