Mini-Bikes Must Comply With State Law

Frankfort--All persons operating motor vehicles on public streets or highways in Kentucky must not only comply with all of the requirements for other motor vehicle operators, but must of the miniature vehicles being operated also bring their minibikes into com-

pliance with state safety regulations. Department officials said a large percentage of the mini-bikes are being operated without license plates. Many of the operators do not have drivers' licenses, and some are as young as nine or ten-year olds. The Department pointed out that mini-bikes, like all other motor vehicles, must be licensed if they are to be operated on streets and highways. Before such a vehicle can be licensed, it must be equipped with adequate brakes, horns, lights, brakes and other equipment required by state laws, and if involved in an accident the owner and operator must comply with the Financial Responsibility Law as do other motorists. Riders of mini-bikes must have valid driver's licenses, and after June 13, 1968, be equipped with helmet and goggles or use a windscreen on the vehicles, since the small bikes fall into the same category with full-size motorcycles and motorbikes, and are subject to the same regulations. Department officials said they do not encourage use of the miniature vehicles in traffic under any circumstances, but that if they are to be operated on public roads and streets, both the vehicles and operators must comply with state laws.
