Student Advisory Commission Named

FRANKFORT--Gov. Louis B. Nunn continues to bring more college students into public affairs--a program he adopted when he assumed office a year ago.

His latest move is the appointment of a 41-member Student Advisory Commission consisting of one student government president at nearly every public university in the state. The commission, Governor Nunn said, will not only advise the Governor on the problems and ideas of Kentucky youth but will also be charged with the responsibility of actively involving young Kentuckians, whom he called the "constructive majority" in solving the problems of the Commonwealth.

The Governor asked the student body presidents to serve on the Commission "to make sure that young Kentuckians have an opportunity to shape the future."

Governor Nunn said, "Too often the only spokesman for this generation have been a vocal destructive or misdirected minority presenting to speak for the majority of students."

"I am establishing this Commission to make sure the constructive, imaginative youth of Kentucky will be heard and to serve Kentucky."

Other new ideas for students Governor Nunn has inaugurated include the naming of students at the governing body of every state university, naming of members of the state senate and the first legislative aide program in the history of Kentucky's general assembly.
