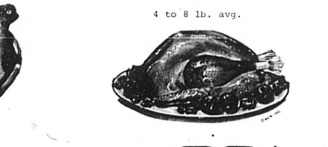
Lake Cumberland Still One Of South's Largest Lakes

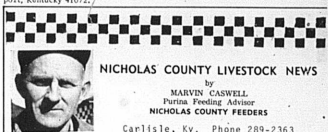
