Stripping Room Chores Important Now That Market Opening Near

Check stripping rooms carefully and strip correctly, says the Massey, U.S. Cooperative Extension Service tobacco specialist. Stripping is an important phase of market preparation.

(1) Make sure the leaf is broken cleanly from the stalk and leaf, but do not leave shreds of stem on the leaves.

(2) Do not take down more tobacco than can be handled in two day's working time. When tobacco is ready to strip, strip it, don't leave the crop hanging in the barn, as it can decay.

(3) Clean out the stripping room, check lights and make sure there is one good light for each two strippers. Put in new and recommended light tubes if necessary. The 40-watt fluorescent bulb (not the incandescent bulb) is the best, as it can decay.

(4) Strip crisp into the five basic grades—flings, lugs, bright leaf, red leaf and tips. There probably will be a strong demand for flings and tips this year. Mr. Massey says that makes grade sorting still more important. Stripping into the five basic grades assures you of market price.

(5) Use a wooden hand-press, pressing each 12- to 14-leaf stick tightly for 10 to 15 minutes. Use a mechanical (hydraulic, electric) press, and don't overpress with the hand press.

(6) Put pressed tobacco in "chicken-move" bulk bins. Usually, move tobacco into the wild bulk about 10 days before the market.

(7) Cover baled tobacco to protect it from foreign matter in the barn, and use a tarpaulin to cover it entirely to make it safe.
