

Saipan Faces Peaceful Era

Jugglers trot gingerly in some areas of tropical Saipan. Live ammunition still litters the Pacific island, scene of bitter fighting in World War II. The 1944 battle between American and Japanese forces left the islanders impoverished. "It was far from getting back to business as usual with only a few minor adjustments," said an occupation officer. "There were

no houses, no government, nothing." The rugged island eventually recovered, but now the United States faces another massive rebuilding project on Saipan, the National Geographic Society says. A powerful typhoon recently leveled homes and crops.

Sept. 7 Voter Registration Deadline

FRANKFORT--Saturday, Sept. 7, is the last day to register to vote in this year's national election of a President and a Vice President, and the Kentucky election of a United States Senator and seven U. S. Representatives.

This deadline applies only to unregistered eligible persons because once a person is registered to vote in Kentucky, he does not have to re-register unless he moves to another precinct, change his name by marriage or other legal process, or is removed from the registration books for failure to vote for two consecu-

utive years. To be eligible to vote, a citizen must be 18 years of age by Nov. 5, election day, and must have lived in the state one year, the county six months, and the precinct 60 days. Prospective voters may register at any time except for periods of 30 days before and five days after a general election or primary. Registration generally throughout Kentucky is in the office of the County Clerk. Some counties occasionally use additional temporary facilities. Polls on election days are open from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Watch Barn Temperatures

Lexington, Ky.-- Temperature and relative humidity (moisture content of the air) inside the barn are important factors in burley curing, says Ira Masale, U. K. Cooperative Extension Service specialist.

(1) Average relative humidity ought to be from 65 to 70 percent and temperature from 60 to 90 degrees F. for best curing, he says. Humidity and temperature recommended here should average those levels over one or two days. It is not necessary to maintain those levels the whole time.

(2) If humidity drops to 50 percent or below, one must add moisture to the air in the barn. This can be done by closing vents (doors) in daytime and opening them at night. Some growers use irrigation systems outside the barn to give a source of moisture.

(3) If humidity gets around 85 percent for as much as 24 hours straight, use propane or natural gas burners, or coke burners, to reduce the level. These fires (heatings) will prevent blueburn.

The start of the curing process is critical in the burley crop, he points out. Much of the profit depends on proper early curing practices.

FBI Accepts Applications

The Federal Bureau of Investigation is accepting applications from high school graduates, both male and female, for clerical work at its Washington, D. C., headquarters.

Palmer M. Baker, Jr., Special Agent in Charge, FBI Louisville, has announced that the starting annual salary for these positions, which require no typing or shorthand ability and no previous experience is \$4,231. Finger-print selection vacancies are filled from the clerical staff and, after 90 days' training, those found qualified are promoted to \$4,600 per year. Additional increases are given at nine- and twelve-month intervals, thus increasing the salary to \$5,145.15, \$5,712 and \$6,281 per year at those stages. The only test necessary is a 20-word spelling test.

There are also positions available for those who can qualify as typist and stenographers with starting annual salaries of \$4,000 and \$3,450 respectively.

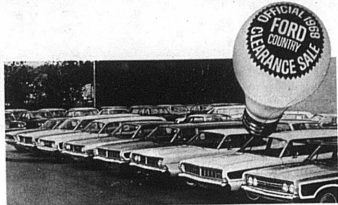
Applicants must be United States citizens, at least 16 years of age, able to pass a required physical examination and a rigid investigation of loyalty, reputation, and character.

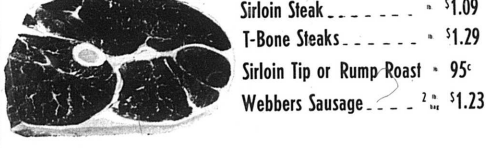
