## New Sea Legislation Extends Delta Queen Service To 1970

CINCINNATI, OHIO—Congress sailed ahead, and the Delta Queen is giving a fast as a US mailboat. It will be at every event—right through the 1969 and 1970 seasons.

The Cincinnati-based Queen appears to be just a short time ago, to be heard nowhere but to the mothball fleet (cause of the broad provisions of the 1960 Motor Vessel Act). The last steamboat still making long hauls on the rivers of America's heart-

land is available.

The 1969 schedule includes 28 trips, with the first half of them originating in cities other than Cincinnati. Eight trips will depart from Cincinnati for Memphis, Tenn., and New Orleans. The season runs from February 7 through November 30, 1969, and the first full-blown cruise will be the Mardi Gras, February 12.
