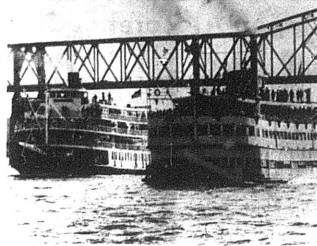


### Derby Steamboat Race Set For Tues., April 29
