one sheet of paper to make out their returns, the card says.

In the past, taxpayers who used the 1040A could not take advantage of certain tax credits or deductions and could not itemize their deductions. A principal reason for making the change to the new form is to enable taxpayers to take full advantage of the tax benefits the law provides, the postcard says.

Most taxpayers should receive their individual tax forms and instructions by mail the first week of January.

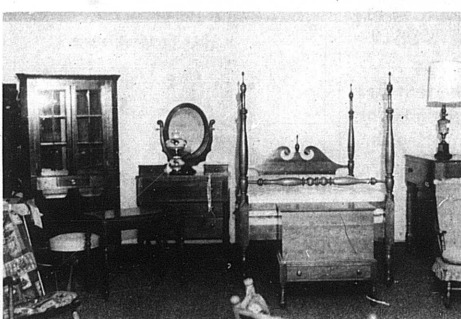
