

History Of Commander Bowen's USS Herbert J. Thomas

USS HERBERT J. THOMAS was launched at Bath, Maine, in March 1945, and commissioned at Boston in March 1945. She is named for a prominent American naval aviator, who was killed at Bougainville in 1943, when he drove the first Japanese aircraft carrier to the sea. The ship was the first of the USS HERBERT J. From the end of the Korean War until 1964 when she entered the Naval Reserve, she served in the Pacific and Atlantic Oceans. She was the first of her class to be named after a living man. Following her commissioning, she was assigned to the Western Pacific Naval Force to support the occupation of Japan and Korea at the end of World War II. She operated in the Western Pacific from 1945 until the outbreak of the Korean War in 1950. From 1950 to 1953 she operated in the Western Pacific, and was the first of her class to be named after a living man.

Experiment will continue aboard her for several years to determine the effectiveness and to correct deficiencies. Since her conversion in 1965, she has made two West Nile virus deployments and operated for several months in the Sea of Japan following the capture of USS PUEBLO by the North Koreans. For her shore bombardment and gun-fire support operations in Viet Nam in the 1970s, she was awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor.
