Medical experts have concluded that tuberculosis is no longer contagious in the same way it once was. The disease is now considered a chronic condition that can be managed with medication. Experts note that the bacteria responsible for TB are now often found in the lungs of patients who have been treated with modern drugs.

Food Stamp Revisions

FRANKFORT — Extra help for the lowest income families in Kentucky's 152 counties with food stamps is now available, Economic Security Commissioner Eugene Coas announced today. He said changes in the Food Stamp program announced recently by the U.S. Department of Agriculture became effective, Feb. 3, in Kentucky.
Families with less than \$70 a month net income will receive more bonus or free coupons than before, Coas explained.
An example, Coas noted, would be a family of four with a monthly income of \$50 which previously paid \$2 and received 145 worth of food stamps coupons. Under the revised rules, the same family would pay the same and receive \$28 worth of coupons, a \$10 a month increase.
