

Greyhounds Romp Over Jackets 66-0

Friday, Sept. 26 proved to be black Friday for the Nicholas County Blue-Jackets and their fans. This came as a result of the humiliating 66-0 defeat handed down by the Farris Greyhounds.

The only player who had anything good done his way was "Pat" P. P., 135 pound junior halfback, Donnie Watson. He scored three times, two separate runs for five and 13 yards and as a final, crossed the goal line on a 33-yard pass play from Jeff Thompson. The Jackets played rugged ball from the opening kick-off and still hadn't improved when the dust cleared as minutes later.

The Nicholas defense scheme was completely over-whelmed by the fan-

atic offensive display by the Greyhounds who scored in every quarter. The Jacket offense wasn't a great acter as they had a treacherous total of 37 yards rushing and really pulled a dress on their own complete pass of seven attempts for all of 4 yards. This was compared to a 127 yards for 157 yards and 201 total yards rushing. In addition to that extra scored in every frame.

To add to the misery, Nicholas County Junior Center, Dennis Dotson was injured in the 6:32 left in the 3rd quarter. He received no injuries. It is reported that he will miss Friday's game with Bath County.

The Jackets gave the fans something to

pell about in his second quarter play a drive that started on the Jackson 46, a 13 yard penalty moved the Jackets to the 40 yard line. This was a 30 yard drive moved on the 32 with 300 yards for the first half.

V.A. Questions
Q.—To qualify for G.I. Bill educational benefits, is service in Viet Nam a requirement?
A. No. Qualification is based on when a veteran served in the armed forces and not where he was stationed. You are eligible if you were released after Jan. 31, 1955, with at least 181 active duty of for a service-connected disability. Service must have been other than dishonorable.

Q.—You are attending school under the G.I. Bill, but want to transfer to another school. What should I do?
A. You must get a new certificate of eligibility if you change either your school or the school which you attend. Contact your nearest VA office for the application form.

Q.—Since both my wife and I are veterans, can both of us claim one child as a dependent to qualify for increased educational assistance? I realize, of course, that each of us can't claim the other as a dependent. I want to know if you can qualify for the increased educational assistance on the basis of your claiming your wife as a dependent and your wife claiming the law as a dependent.
