Individual Taxpayers Ask IRS

Should you bring a tax expert with you when you are called in for an audit? A professional tax help is usually not needed during the examination of a return. However, you may bring someone to represent you if you wish.

The reason for examining a return is to determine whether it is accurate and complete. To do this, you should have the records to back up the income and amounts shown on your return.

Q-Can you deduct anything for employment agency fees?
A- Fees paid to employment agency for securing a job are deductible when you initiate your deductions.

Q-Use my country club to entertain some of my customers. Am I allowed any deduction for my club fees and expenses?
A-Your business lunches at the country club would be deductible just as a business lunch any place would be, if other entertainment expenses at the club may also qualify.

A portion of your annual club dues may be deducted if you use the country club more than 50 percent of the time for business purposes. Membership or initiation fees paid once for membership privileges are generally considered a capital expense and are not deductible.

To show you use the club more than half the time for business purposes, keep a record of the days you and your family use the club's facilities, and indicate whether for business or personal purposes.

If you use the club for both business and personal purposes on the same day, club dues are discussed in Publication 461, "Travel, Entertainment and Club Expenses." For a free copy, write to "Buy" card to your District Director.
