## Kay's Kitchen

Now for the long awaited desserts. Most of you probably have these first two cake recipes. They are easy to make, travel well and keep moist all the last time.

**OATMEAL CAKE**

Combine and let stand 15 minutes 1/4 cup boiling water and one cup Quick Oatmeal. Cream cup white sugar, 1/2 cup brown sugar and 1 stick of margarine. Add 2 eggs, 1 teaspoon vanilla, 1 teaspoon soda, 1/2 teaspoon cinnamon, 1 1/2 cups flour. Mix well and add oatmeal mixture. Bake in greased 9x13 inch pan about 45 minutes at 350 degrees.

**With this cake come a story too. A lady, having had dinner at the Waldorf in New York and being asked to serve, she asked the headwaiter if she could have the recipe. He said it would be sent to her room which it was. When she returned (I've heard the story many times for the recipe). The details from there are just as varied, but one for sure, just as many people as possible would get the recipe free. Mine came from a dear friend in Lexington.**

**GRANDMOTHER'S BREAD PUDDING**

Mix together 2 cups pre-mixed flour, a cup white sugar, 4 rounded tablespoons margarine, 1/2 cup milk, 1/2 cup raisins, 1/2 cup coffee, 3/4 cup Miracle Whip Salad Dressing, 1/2 cup vanilla. Mix well. Bake in 8"x8"x2" well greased pan at 325 degrees until done, about 30 minutes.

**When cool leave in pan and let with 2 cups confectionary sugar, tablespoons margarine that is at room temperature, and enough shortening but make a good cup of coffee and what is left sit down and drink it and admire my work. The icing never fails. Keep a long time and is good on anything that calls for chocolate icing.**

**Due to space problems, and I do not mean "Outer Space," part of the marriage of Kay and Bob must be omitted. However, the basic ingredients are here.**

1 cup sugar, 1/4 cup shortening (just a good milk), 2 tablespoons water, 1/2 cup flour, 1 teaspoon cinnamon, 1/2 teaspoon cloves, 1/2 teaspoon allspice, and 1 teaspoon soda. Add 1/2 cup broken pecans, and some raisins.
