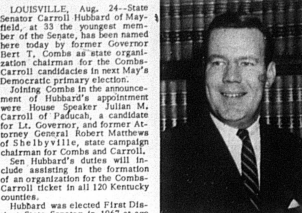


Sen. Hubbard Is Named Combs Organization Chairman for Primary

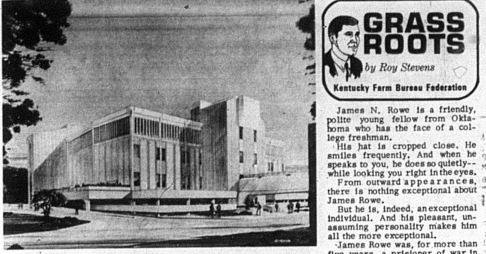

The voluntary code outlines the responsibilities of lawyers, judges and news media insuring fairness in news coverage of civil criminal and juvenile court trials.
