

# Kay's Kitchen

This week the recipe will be for salads that I think are especially good and colorful to serve at Christmas time.

**CRANBERRY SALAD**  
2 boxes of Cherry Jello  
2 cups boiling water  
1 1/2 cups cold water  
juice of one orange  
cups sugar  
2 cups ground cranberries  
1 small can crushed pineapple about 1 tablespoon or more of orange peel.  
Mix all ingredients and pour into individual molds or a large flat dish and cut into squares when ready to serve.

**CHERRY SHERRY SALAD**  
Drain and remove seeds from a can of black cherries and stuff with almonds or pecans. Dissolve 1 package of Cherry Jello in 1 cup of hot water from can of cherries. You may need to add a bit of water to make 1 cup. Cool and add 1 cup of Sherry—(Select a Sherry not too sweet nor too dry). When jello begins to set carefully add the cherries.  
I usually mold this in a flat baking dish so I can add more almonds on the top and cut into squares. You can put silvered almonds in bottom of individual molds. This serves six.

**THE GREEN SALAD**  
1 3 ounce package of cream cheese  
1 small can crushed pineapple drained  
1/2 cup diced finely celery  
1/2 cup chopped nuts  
Add to 1 package of lime jello made with 1 3/4 cups water and the juice from the pineapple heated to dissolve jello.  
This recipe can very easily be modified to serve more.  
**GINGER ALE FRUIT SALAD**  
1 tablespoon gelatin  
1 tablespoon cold water  
1/2 cup boiling water  
1/2 cup ginger ale  
1/2 cup lemon juice  
1/2 cup seedless green grapes cut in half or sliced  
1/2 cup diced pineapple  
1/2 cup diced celery  
1 tablespoon finely chopped preserved ginger  
1/4 cup chopped pecans  
Soften gelatin in cold water; add boiling water and stir until gelatin is dissolved. Add sugar, salt, ginger ale and lemon juice; chill. When slightly thickened, fold in whipped cream, fruits, celery, grapes and pineapple. Turn into individual molds; chill. Unmold on lettuce and garnish with clusters of seedless grapes.  
A word about the preserved ginger. It is very difficult to find and expensive. To unmask you like, very hot biting taste would advise to omit the ginger. However to mix the ginger really makes this salad quite different.  
Now if you want to omit the salad there is nothing more attractive or more than a spiced fruit bowl. Here it is again  
Use fruits of your choice, drained, saving juice. Chime please

1 3/4 cups boiling water  
1 1/2 cups cold water  
juice of one orange  
cups sugar  
2 cups ground cranberries

**Methodist Orphanage**

Sunday, Nov. 21, about 29 people from the United Methodist Church visited the Methodist Orphanage at Versailles. The home and grounds consist of 275 acres. The residents of the home, with some other helpers, tend 130 acres. The other 175 are rented out. All their beef, pork and vegetables are raised on the 100 acres. They have 80 children and turn down many others, for there isn't room for them. 105 of these are children from Nicholas County, but a few are from Miller County.



The superintendent of the home is Rev. James W. Aweitt, a native of Nicholas County. His grandfather, Rev. James E. Wright, preached at Nicholas County at the following Methodist Churches: Mt. Carmel, Rose Hills, Mt. Pleasant, Mt. Marshall, which later moved to Oakland Mills; Wagonwheel, and Stillwell. This was about 1900. He preached at these churches five years. Later he preached at Morefield. Just how many churches on this charge I don't know.
