

Cold Spell Compensations

Extended spells of zero or near-zero temperature with lots of snow and ice may be hard to bear, but according to some entomologists, have their compensations and are especially beneficial to farmers and gardeners. These cold spells kill off hordes of harmful flying insects.

Many insects pass each winter of refuge under bark on trees, in weed stems, in corn cobs and in a variety of other natural sanctuaries. Some return in the form of eggs or larvae under ground. Some protected by blankets of insulating sludge in water-filled holes. Many have supermedia to carry them to warm places where they are cared for until spring. Without the protective cold to freeze the ground and to penetrate with fatal effects the protective devices of many insects, the chances are that the bug problem would be much worse than it is here in Kentucky. At least this is the consensus of a lot of gardeners and farmers.

Like all other living things, many insects go to great lengths to assure survival during the winter months.

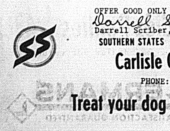

U.S. Individual Taxpayers Ask IRS

This column of questions and answers on tax matters is provided by the local office of the U.S. Internal Revenue Service and is published as a public service to taxpayers. The column answers questions most frequently asked by taxpayers.

Q: Where can I get a copy of my tax return?

A: A copy of your Federal Income Tax 1970 return may be purchased from most IRS offices for one dollar. A return of a child who has never been issued a Social Security card may be obtained from the office where the 1969 tax return was filed. The fee is one dollar.

Q: Where can I get a copy of my tax return?

Q: What is a refund?

A: A refund is the amount of tax that has been paid in excess of the amount that is due. It is the amount that the IRS has paid to you. It can be for income tax, estate tax, or gift tax.
