## Nicholas County Memories

Again it has been my pleasure to attend the Annual Legion Blackberry Festival, and to sit on the Old-Timers bench in the Court House "yard", gazing across the street at long remembered store fronts, and trying to recall the names under which the businesses were conducted fifty or sixty years.

Starting with the C.C. Cole building it is interesting to note that it still houses a men's clothing store operated under the same name. Next to Cole's was the T.C. Collier dry goods store, later operated by Mrs. Patton and still later by Jim Patton and Ollie Brayfield. Ruffitt Bros. grocery and meat market was next door, where "Uncle Woody" Darrell Clark, when not engaged in helping Aunt Riley run the Parks Hill Camp ground Dining Room, in the next

building Harvey Lee and W.P. Ross had their men's clothing and furnishings store, catering to the younger gentlemen of the community.

Next is the "Frey Block" built in 1892 by John H. Frey, later Carlisle's progressive mayor, under whose administration the City Building on Chestnut Street was constructed. It is the east section of the Frey building was the John G. Powell Hardware Store, later operated by Tilton and Roy C. Taylor had their jewelry store; later a law office and later a grocery store owned by Elsie McIntire. Now an optician's office is there.

Next then to the last building in the block is the one built by Gus Hyman. In 1892 to replace his dry-goods store, destroyed by a big fire. The Faris Fire
