A rather serious problem has been brought to our attention concerning the Little League and Babe Ruth League baseball teams. Apparently we were unaware of it, may be it is too!

There are approximately 155 Nicholas County boys playing in both leagues which means that over 300 parents are associated with the leagues.

Yet, there is a lack of umpires, scorekeepers and concession stand workers at almost every game.

Both leagues are often full and manned by volunteers who spend many hours each week from the beginning of May until the middle of July. In addition, the sponsors bear the expense of uniforms which is estimated to cost around \$25 per boy. Some of these volunteers are parents of the players, but many are not.

It seems only logical to us that since 300 parents have boys playing in the leagues that they, umpires, scorekeepers and concession stand workers would be plentiful--and not work a hardship on a few.

The concessions are one way of meeting the expenses mentioned from the leagues going. An example of such expense are the uniforms which are necessary. Won't you, as a non-involving parent whose child is benefiting from the leagues, help to help sell concessions so that soliciting will not become necessary? Won't some of you umpire and keep score?
