By virtue of a judgment and order of sale of the Nicholas Circuit Court, entered on May 29, 1970, in the above styled action, the undersigned Master Commissioner will, on June 20, 1970, at or about the hour of 2:00 P.M., at the Court House, downtown Carlisle, Nicholas County, Kentucky, receive bids for cash, or on credit, for twelve months from date of sale, the following described property:

One certain lot or parcel of land lying in Nicholas County, Kentucky, in what is known as the Village of Henryville, near to and north of the town of Carlisle, Kentucky, and known as Lot #18 on the plat of said Village, bounded as follows: On the north by Freeman Street; on the east by Elm Street; south by Williams Alley, and west by Lot 20.

One certain lot or parcel of land lying in Nicholas County, Kentucky, and known as the parcel of land on the grade of the Carlisle and Parks Ferry Turnpike Road and bounded on the north by the center of said Turnpike grade on the east by the lot of A. Norman, on the southeast by the land of B.W. Matheny, and on the southwest by the lot of Daniel Thomas, deceased, containing one and one-half acres, more or less.
