

'Tribute To A Dog' Has Been Translated Into Over 40 Languages

Senator Vest, of Missouri, was attending court in a country town, and while waiting for the trial of a case in which he was interested, a dog came to help him. He was paid a fee of \$250 by the plaintiff. Voluntary evidence was introduced to show that the defendant had shot the dog in malice, while the other evidence went to show that the dog had attacked the defendant. Vest took no part in the trial and was not named as a witness. The attorney, however, urged him to make a speech, "else their client would not think he had earned his fee. Being thus urged, he arose, scanned the face of each jurymen for a moment and said:

best friend a man has in the world may turn against him and become his enemy. His poorer daughter that he has reared with loving care may prove ungrateful. Those who are nearest and dearest to us, those whom we trust with our happiness and our good name, may become traitors to our faith. The money that a man has, he may lose. It flies away from him, perhaps, when he needs it most. A man's reputation may be sacrificed in a moment of ill-considered action. The people who are prone to fall on their knees to do us honor when failure strikes its clouds upon

our heads. The one absolutely unselfish friend that man can have in this selfish world, the one that never deserts him, the one that never proves ungrateful or treacherous, is his dog. A man's dog stands by him in poverty and in prosperity, in sickness and in health, and in the hour of his grief and sorrow he will lick his wounds and soothe his sorrows that come in encounter with the roughness of the world. He guards the sleep of his pauper master, as if he were a prince. When all other friends

desert he remains. When riches take wings and reputation falls to pieces, he is as constant in his love as the sun in its journey through the heavens. If fortune drives the master forth an outcast in the world, friendless and homeless, the faithful dog asks no higher privilege than that of accompanying him, to guard against danger, to fight against his enemies, and when the last scene of all comes, and death takes the master in his embrace, and his body is laid away in the cold ground, no master if all other friends pursue their way, there by the graveside will be the noble dog, found, his head between his

paws, his eyes sad, but open in watchfulness, faithful and true even in death."

Senator Vest sat down. He had spoken in a low voice, without any gesture. He made no reference to the evidence of the merits of the

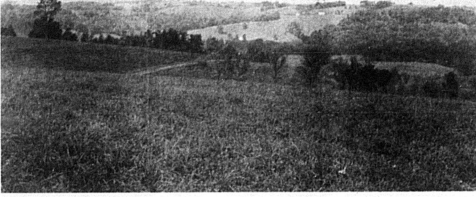

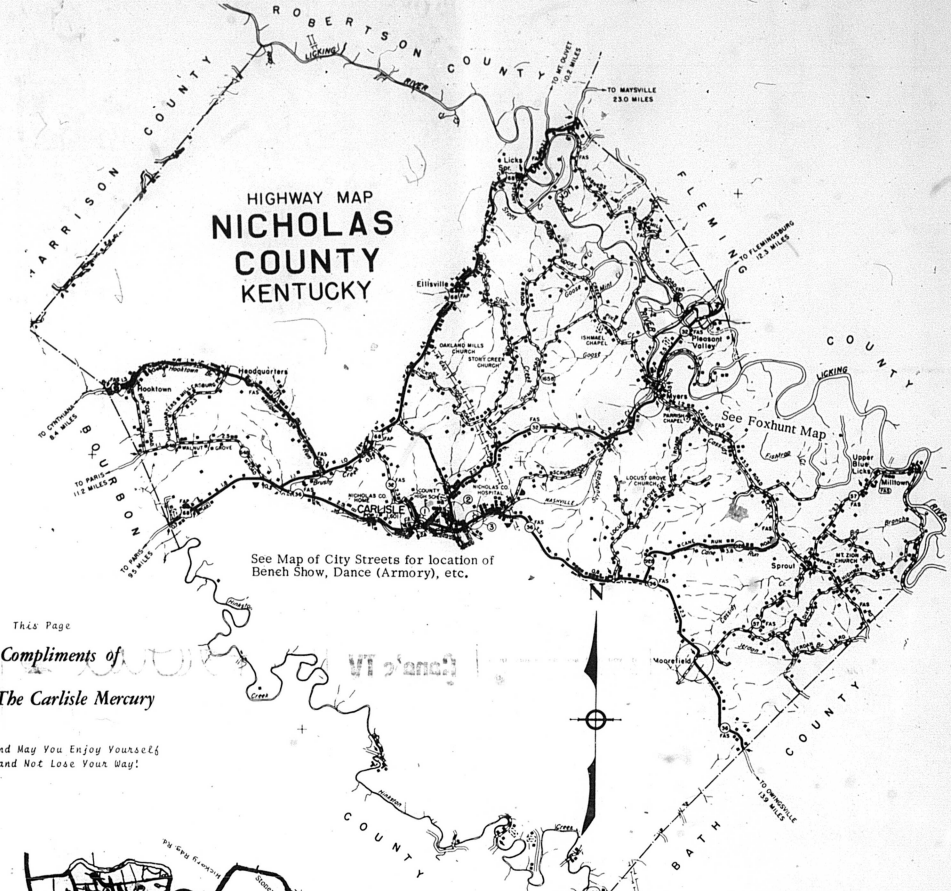
