

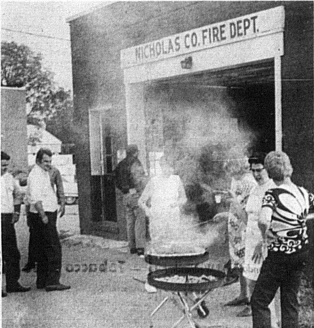
Volunteer Nicholas County Fire Department Social Held Sunday

ALL-Season Fertilizer

Kentucky Farmers May Want To Apply Fertilizer This Fall

Here are a few points farmers should keep in mind when contemplating applying their fertilizer purchase or application times:

1. During the "off-season," a dealer can provide farmers with much better service than during peak demand periods. In addition the farmer can often get a discount for "off-season" purchases.
2. Application of phosphate and potash at a convenient time before a crop is planned ensures these nutrients will be on the soil when they are actually needed. This can save farmers time and labor.
3. Crops have a much better chance of winter time freeze survival if they go into winter with a healthy root system. Application of fertilizer before the crop goes dormant in late fall—especially potash—will help the plant build up its winter food reserves.
4. The UK experts advise farmers to have well tests run now and check over their needs for fertilizer next spring and apply phosphate and potash now.
