If you don't have a high school diploma and still want to get one, you can use it as a study kit...

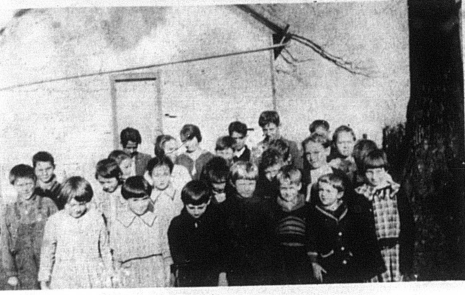
The "TV High School" will begin its half-hour lessons on Sept. 21. Two different lessons will be broadcast per week...
